The action of **BERMASIN G1000** nergetic and processing times must be followed carefully because they must never be too prolonged.

USAGE METHOD

Recommended doses are listed here for some of the most common types of hides processed:

- 0.4% to 0.8% is used for calf skins for shoe uppers
- 0.4% to 0.8% is used for bovine hides for shoe uppers
- 1% to 1.5% is used for bovine hides for nappa
- 1.5% to 2% is used for young goat's skins
- 0.6% to 0.8% is used for ram's skins for shoe uppers or linings
- 1.5% to 2.5% is used for pigskins for clothing
